### **All in one Cake**

- 4oz butter
- 4oz castor sugar
- 2 standard eggs
- ¼ pint milk (less 2 tbsp )
- 8-12oz mixed fruit
- 8oz self raising flour )
- 1level tsp mixed spice ) sieved
- Walnut halves (optional)

Place all the ingredients except the walnuts in a mixing bowl .Beat until well mixed. Place in a greased and bottom lined 2lb loaf tin (or 2x 1lb). Smooth top and place on walnuts. Bake in middle of oven.Gas3,325F for 1½ hours. Time may vary depending on type of oven ,but check! Leave for 10 mins then turn out to cool on wire rack.
