## Re-dedication of the War Memorial at Skipsea, 11a.m. Sunday 1st June, 2008

In Skipsea on Sunday June 1st, the rededication of the War Memorial took place, after a morning of torrential rain the skies cleared just in time for the crowd of about 30 people that had gathered around the memorial, to listen to the Reverend Jean Mayland as she began her service of re-dedication. She welcomed everyone and said how wonderful the War Memorial looked after its makeover, ( because late last year a car ran into the railings and did quite a bit of damage ). Attending the service was Councillor R Anderson BEM, the branch chairman of the

British Legion and his vice chairman Mr T Jackson who was the standard bearer. After hymns were sung and prayers said the Minister went on to dedicate the memorial. The list of those to be remembered was read out by Mr P Graylen, 11 from Skipsea 10 from Barmston, 3 from Ulrome and 1 from Fraisthorpe.

Mr Graylen then laid a wreath and the last post was played by Mr J Hall and as the haunting notes of the bugle died away a two minutes silence was held then Mr Hall played the Reveille. Another hymn was sung before the Minister gave The Blessing, she then thanked everyone for attending.

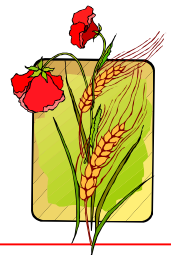

## Skipsea Chapel

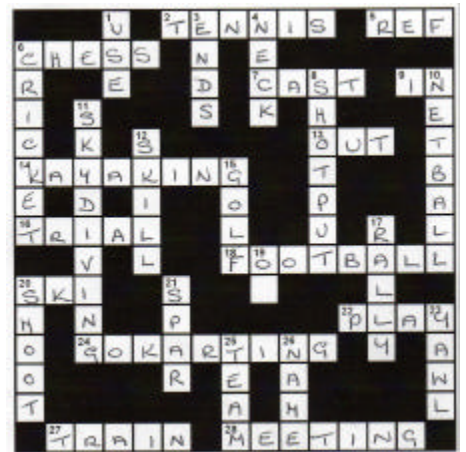

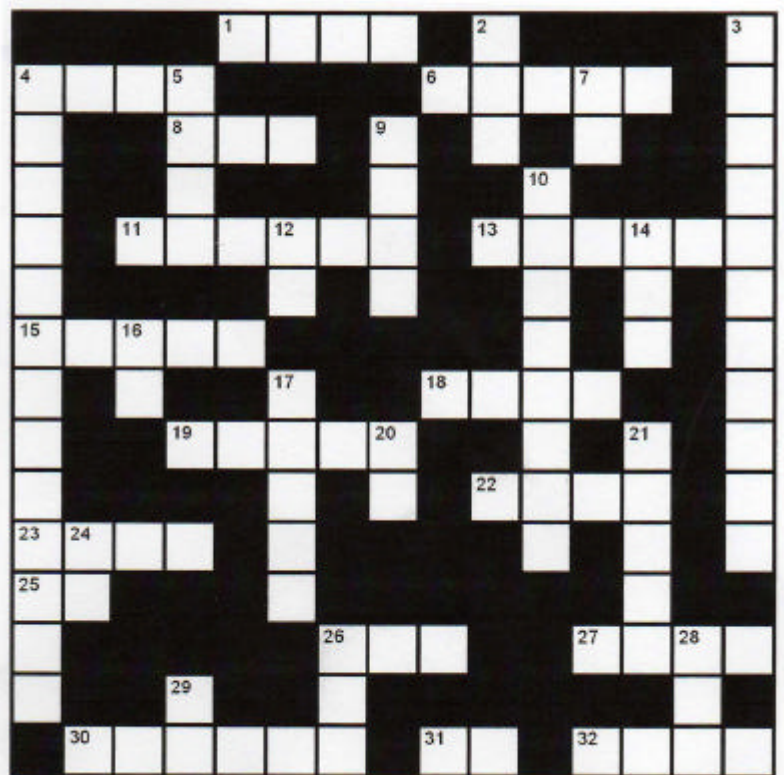
## Over 50`s Club
