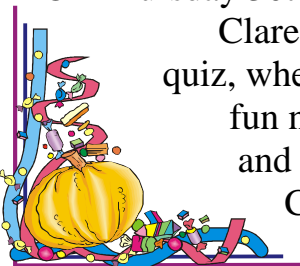
## Halloween Howl

## Indoor Short Mat Bowling and Kurling



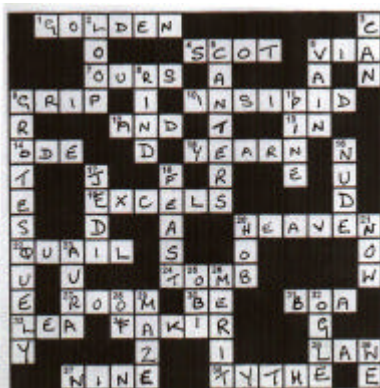
On a Monday afternoon in the Village Hall there can be heard the laughing and giggling of people having fun, they are playing a game of

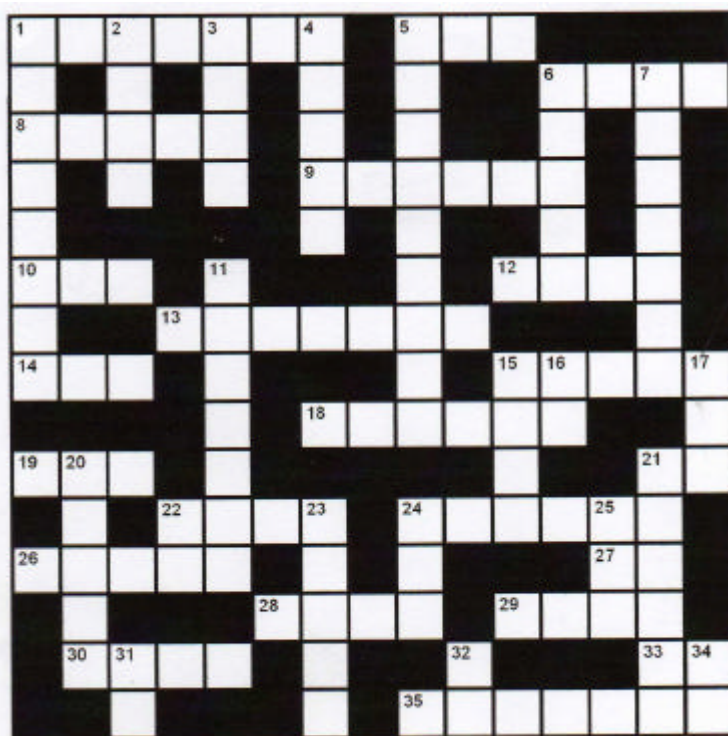

Pumpkin Panade (serves 10)

1 6/7lb Pumpkin

4 pints water

1lb Potatoes

Salt & pepper for seasoning

4 fl oz. cream

Croutons made from 3 slices of bread

2oz. Gruyere cheese (grated)

Cut out and discard the lid from the top of pumpkin, scoop out seeds with a spoon. Remove flesh from interior with a knife and a spoon and be careful nit to pierce the shell. Put the shell on a heavy baking sheet.

Cut up 1lb of the flesh into pieces9 the rest can used in a flan or tart) put the pieces in a pan with the water and the potatoes, season with the salt and pepper bring up to boil, cook covered for 45 minutes. then put the soup through a sieve, add the cream. Pour the soup into the hollowed out shell, sprinkle the surface with the croutons and cheese.

Put into a pre heated oven 220°(425F or Mark7) and cook for 15minutres.

Bring the soup filled pumpkin shell to the table and serve
