So come on Skipsea Parish Council—don't let our children down.

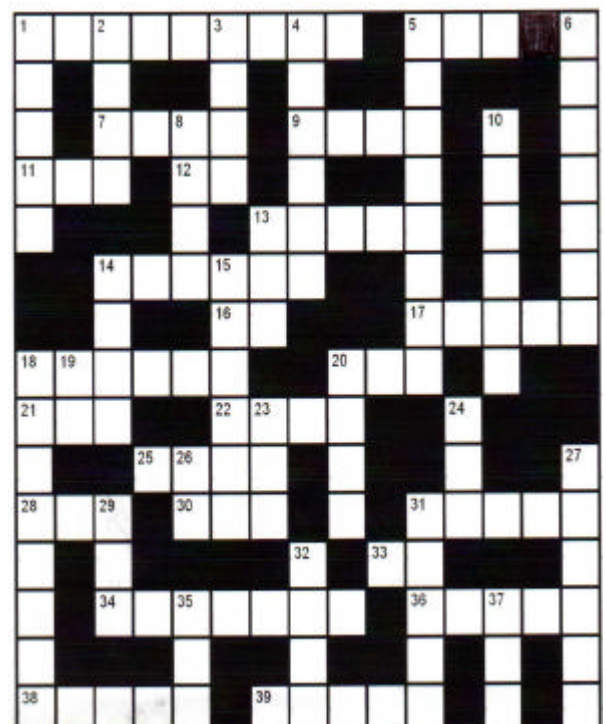

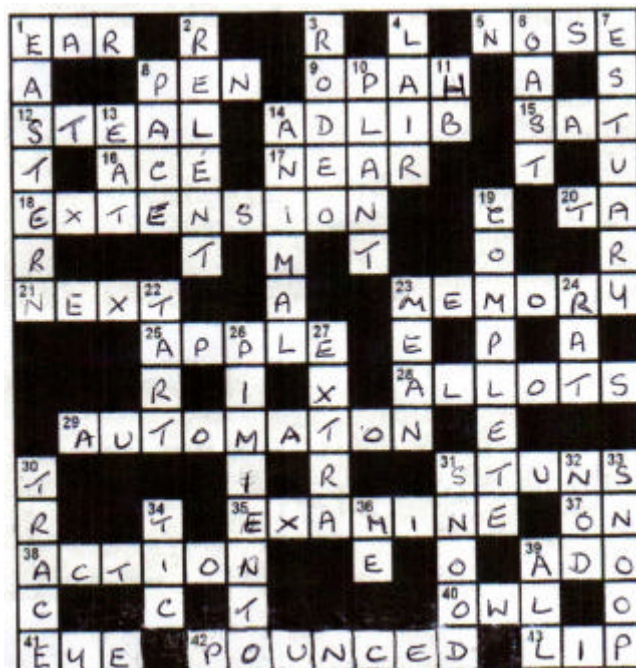
