

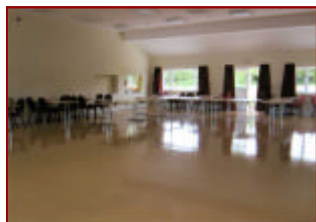

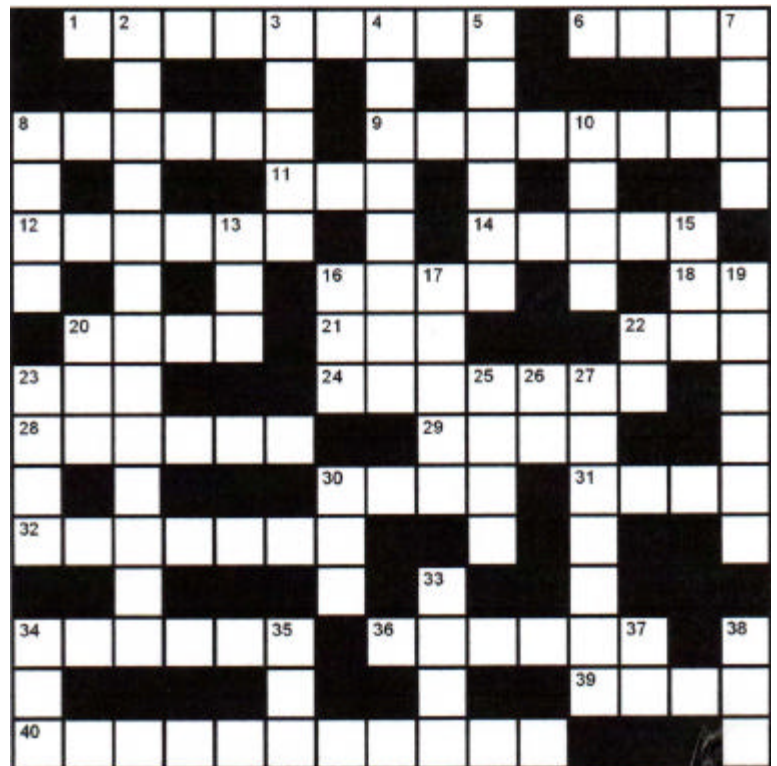

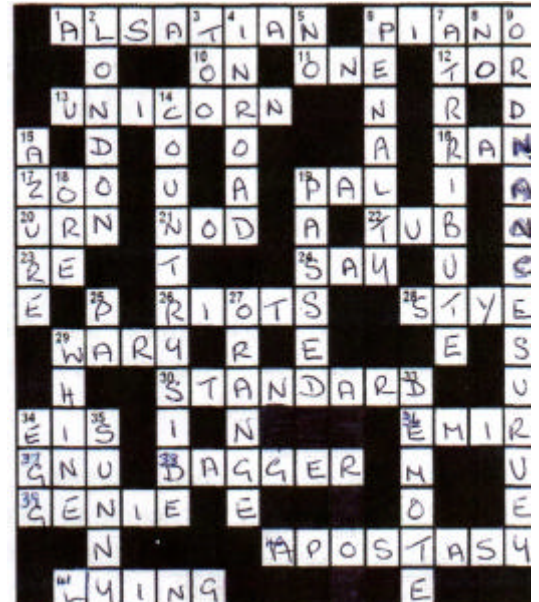

**Trip to Nepal**

Ian Banks, who is travelling to Nepal in late October, is collecting second hand children's clothes for the children of Chuplung, in the remote Himalayan foothills. Even in this impoverished area, the children, aged 4-11, are obliged to wear a school uniform. However, this often means that the parents cannot afford to buy play clothes for their children, meaning that the children have to live in their school uniforms, which quickly wear out.

In addition to taking play/casual clothes for the children, the UK group which visits Chuplung in the autumn will buy suitable material in Katmandu to have uniforms made up for all the school age children in Chuplung.
