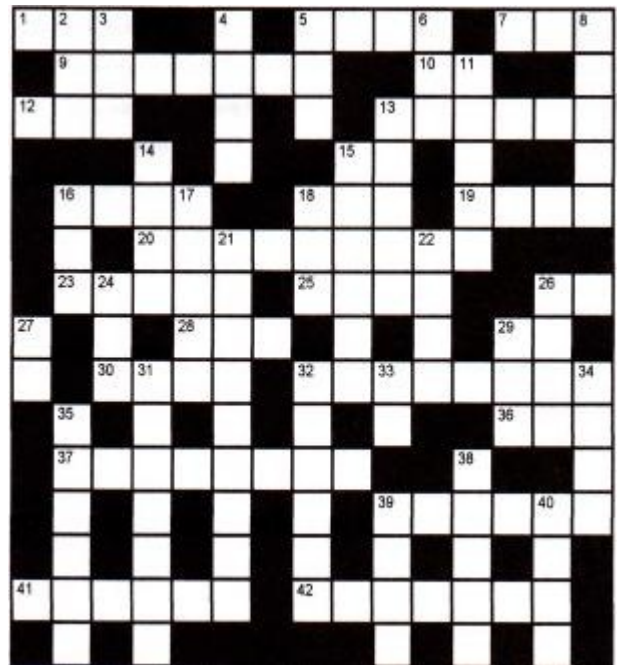

Tea Room

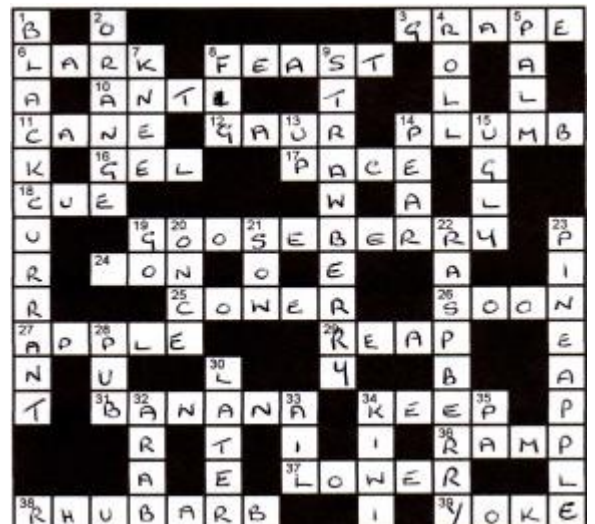
The Tea Room is open weekends and bank holidays, 12pm-5pm, for sandwiches, cakes and Traditional Afternoon Tea
